Sports Day – a chance to show your sporting talents

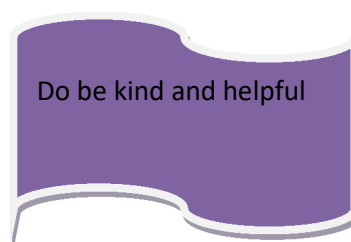
