Outcome:

Pupil Premium

The data is showing that most of the cohort are low on entry when they enter the early years, there is no significant difference in % of pupils achieving a Good Level of development. It is worth noting that the number of pupils who have pupil premium is low when making data comparison.

KS1 2017-18 Outcomes: Pupils premium allocated to an additional teacher focusing on maths and managing phonics programme

- The national average Number Age gain is 17.5 months in only 4 months. The data above shows that pupils made an average of 19 months progress which is above national.
- 71.4% (5/7) of pupils reached age expectation in the KS1 SATS in Maths

- In all subjects, PP pupils are performing better than non pp.

- An additional Teaching Assistant in the Early Years to focus on accelerating pupil progress
- An intervention teacher in KS 1 focusing on maths and managing phonics
- An intervention teacher in UKS 2 focusing on the progress of reading and maths with children just below age expectation
