The data is showing that most of the cohort are low on entry when they enter the early years, the data indicates that fewer pupil premium pupils are achieving a GLD compared to non-pupil premium pupils. It is worth noting that the number of pupils who have pupil premium is low when making a data comparison. There are 4 pupil premium pupils who did not achieve a GLD. There are 3 non pupil premium pupils who did not achieve a GLD.
