

Lift to reveal the print, you can repeat this process to make multiples of designs, creating patterns. You can then add a background colour using the paint pens. Use the felt tips to add text with answers to the questions

You can re-use the printing blocks to make cards or other decorations.

Other ideas for printing...

Here are some other printing ideas using items you may find around the house

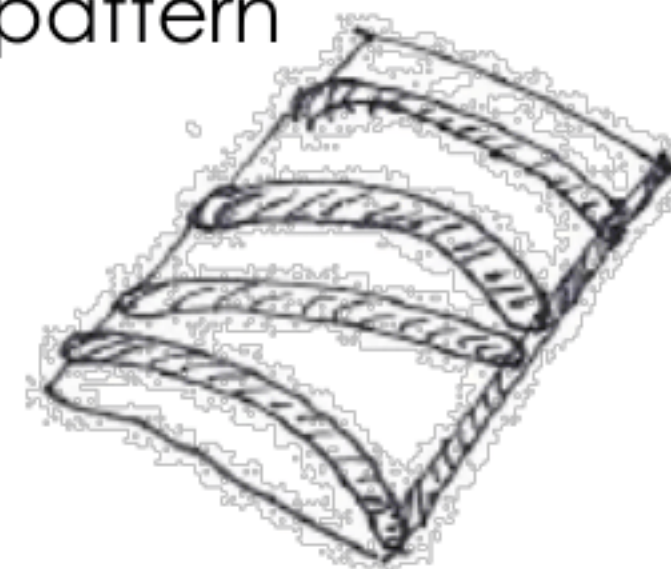
1. Potato Prints



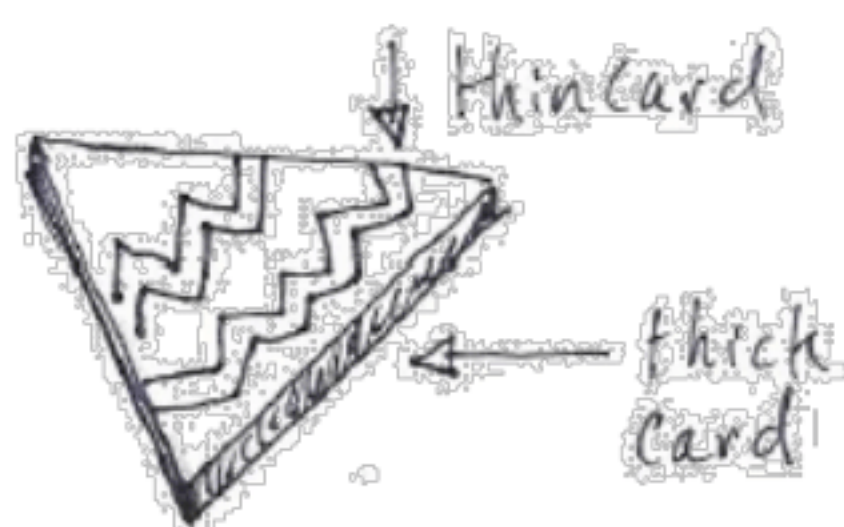
Cut a potato into a shape and cover with paint or paint-pen. Make patterns with repeated prints

2. String and card

Wrap string around a piece of cardboard and cover one side with paint. Use it to create a repeated pattern



3. Card printing blocks



Cut out a large shape in cardboard. Then cut out some smaller shapes in thinner card (try cereal boxes), and glue them on to the larger cardboard shape. Let it dry, then make a tape handle like in the foam board printing. Cover with paint and print
