Parents are reminded to return their sailing permission forms as our first lesson is on Friday 7th June. If a child has not returned their form they will be unable to attend.

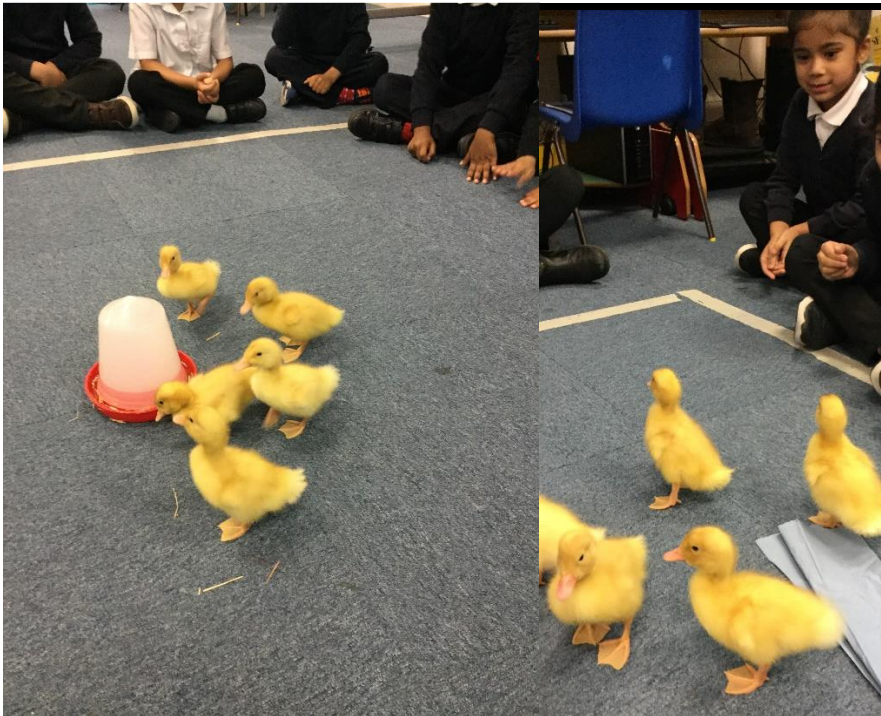
Year 5 School Journey
