Reception school admissions: starting reception in 2019/20

Pupils usually start primary school in the September following their fourth birthday. If your child was born between 1 September 2014 and 31 August 2015 this will be from September 2019. You must complete an application for a reception place, even if your child is already attending the school's nursery.

You must apply via the [eadmissions portal](#). **Closing date for making applications is 15 January 2019.**

How to apply

If your child was born between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016 and you would like a nursery place for September 2019, you must submit an online application by 17 February 2019.

You should apply online via the [eadmissions portal](#).

When you have completed and submitted your application you will receive an email confirmation. You can make changes to your application up until the closing date: 17 February 2019.
